He is currently a Licensed Clinical Social Worker in the State of New York and a Board Certified Diplomate in Clinical Social Work by the American Board of Examiners in Clinical Social Work. Scheinberg served as an Executive Board member of the Suffolk County chapter of the Society of Clinical Social Work from 1984 to 1995.

Scheinberg has participated in many hours of professional development to enhance and advance his clinical repertoire of skills, including Certification in Hypnosis for Past Life Regression by the Dr. Brian Weiss Institute. Scheinberg also maintains an ongoing interest in mind-body and



healing therapies; he is a certified Reiki practitioner and Re-connective healing practitioner.

Scheinberg is a psychotherapist with 28 years of experience in private practice, helping children, adults, couples and families. In 1993, the success of his practice culminated in his opening the Sunrise Counseling Center in Bay Shore, Long Island, New York. Currently, Scheinberg serves as Founder and Director of this agency, for which he supervises a staff of 20 clinical practitioners,

who in turn serve 1,000 people each month. Aside from being a human resources specialist for community organizations, employee assistance programs and managed care insurance companies, Scheinberg continues to serve as a seminar and workshop leader locally and as a business consultant outside of New York State.

In addition to his other responsibilities, Scheinberg has served on a clinical team in New York City Schools for the past 28 years, evaluating children and adolescents who are not functioning well in the classroom because they may have learning disabilities and/or emotional problems.
